2018 Executive Conference Summary

Vision

To provide a platform for improved skills attainment, sharing and cultivation of advanced research and practices with in the prism of Human Wellness, being interchangably influenced by local and global factors

Introduction

At CCON we came together as a community to serve our region's newest neighbors. We gathered in hopes of strengthening our capacity to extend social services to our new neighbors and to provide a small measure of relief to their ongoing efforts in gaining stability for themselves and for their families. CCON welcomed national level speakers to talk about how to help our vulnerable neighbors through the first years of life in the US. CCON also provides the chance to roll up our sleeves and talk with each other about what works and what has yet to be tried. By linking ourselves and our agencies to shared purposes we collectively realized tangible outcomes of strengthening our regional refugee safety net.

Goal

To mobilize and harness the diverse knowledge, capacities, and services of various stakeholders interested to learn from those who interface with refugee and immigrant communities in the USA

Action

CCON was held December 13 and 14, 2018 at Concordia University Wisconsin, School of Pharmacy. It hosted 1000+ attendees.

Conference Evaluation

Participants' feedback was documented through a post-conference online survey that was sent out via email. These survey results demonstrated significant enthusiasm for the conference. A supermajority stated that "this conference has improved my ability to deliver services to new comers" and provided discussions centered on relevant themes.
