OCON4 was focused on becoming a community with refugees and immigrants. We came together virtually to strengthen our relationships and understanding of our newest community members. OCON4 welcomed speakers of different professional and social/cultural backgrounds to share their experiences providing services to refugees or transitioning to life in the United States. Through storytelling and teaching we were given the chance to better understand the strengths and needs of refugee communities. Goal

Mobilize and harness the diverse knowledge, capacities, and services of various stakeholders interested to learn from and with those who interface with refugee and immigrant communities in the USA.

Action

OCON4 was held virtually November 12 and 13, 2020. There were 250 registered participants who represented over 50 different organizations. 7 organizations represented six diverse sectors including healthcare, higher education, K12 education, government, community service, and business.

There were nearly 50 diverse speakers and moderators who provided distinctive insight from their professional and personal backgrounds including healthcare professionals, state and local government officials, community service leaders, and refugees.



Conference Evaluation

Feedback was documented through a post-conference online survey that was sent out via email through Qualtrics. These survey results demonstrated significant enthusiasm for WKH. Participants were able to identify two new resources and agency connections. Please ask for our responses.

Future Steps

OCON is continuing its momentum in creating a space for refugees, immigrants, organizations and assisting agencies to come together and discuss what it takes to together as one community.
