## Be Prepared

Be sure you have alternate contact information, such as a phone number, in case you experience loss of audio or video feed during your interview.

If you are interrupted by unavoidable noise, such as police or fire sirens, apologize for the disruption and ask for a moment until the disruption subsides.

Handle the situation calmly and with poise.

## Basic Interviewing Skills

basic interviewing skills to be mindful of in your preparations.

- x **Research the program** Educate yourself about the program and its unique aspects. Be prepared to share what makes the program interesting to you as an applicant.
- x **Prepare questions to ask your interviewer** Remember, you are interviewing the program just as they are interviewing you. Be prepared to ask questions of your interviewer to demonstrate interest and obtain information you need to help you make decisions for your rank list.
- x **Arrive early.** Just as you want to with an in-person interview, join the video conference a few minutes early to ensure you are settled and ready to begin on time.
